Rania Ekaterinari is Deputy CEO of Public Power Corporation S.A. (“PPC”). She is also Member of the Board of Directors & Member of the Management Board. She is heading the corporate divisions of Finance and of HR. Previously she also headed the Support Operations Division, including IT, procurement, real estate & research center.

She was member of the Supervisory Board of the Greek Independent Power Transmission Operator (ADMIE). She was also Deputy Chairman of the Energy Committee of the Technical Chamber of Greece.

Before PPC, and for more than 10 years, she worked in corporate & investment banking in London and in Athens at Deutsche Bank, BNP Paribas and EFG Eurobank. Before that, she also worked in the oil industry for Texaco in London and in the Caspian region. At the beginning of her career, she worked as an electrical engineer in Greece and in Denmark.

She is the first Greek woman to be announced in 2010 member of the global “Rising Talents Network” of the “Women’s Forum for the Economy and the Society”. She is also a member of the European Network for Women in Leadership (WIL).
