



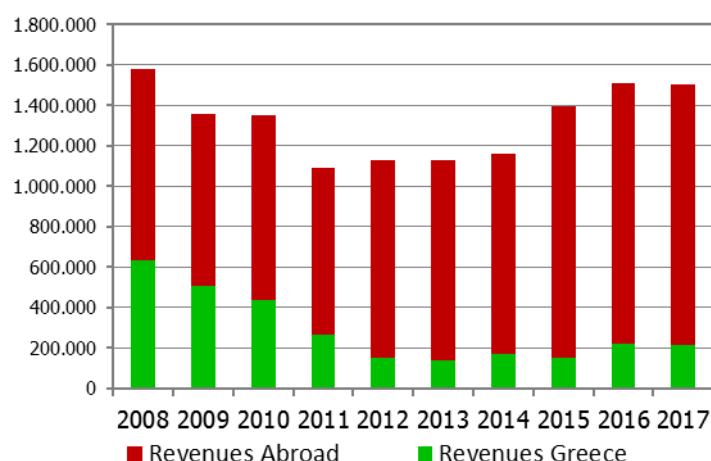

Titan was founded in Greece in 1902. With its headquarters in Greece - where the parent company has been listed on the Athens Stock Exchange since 1912 *the Group owns cement plants in nine countries and is organized in four geographic regions Greece & Western Europe, the USA, Southeastern Europe and the Eastern Mediterranean.* Throughout its history TITAN has aimed to combine operational excellence with respect for people, society and the environment.

The Group's business activities are carried out by both wholly owned companies and by joint ventures with established partners. These activities cover the production, transportation and distribution of cement, concrete, aggregates, fly ash, mortars and other building materials.

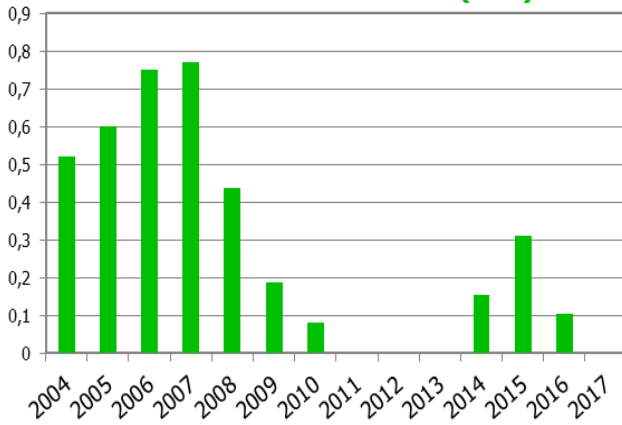

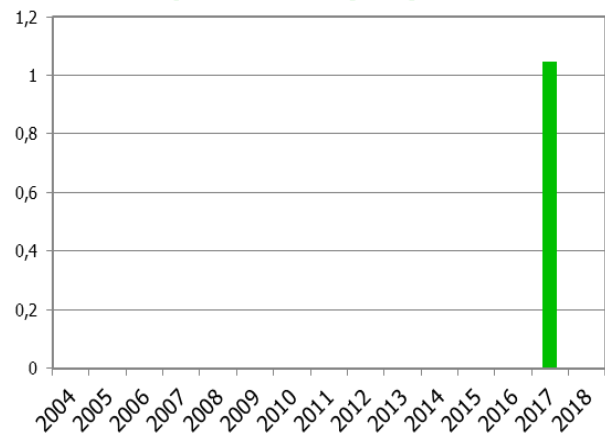

Capital Return (in €)



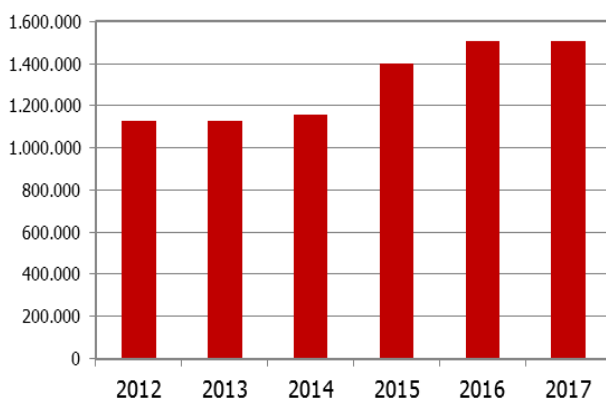

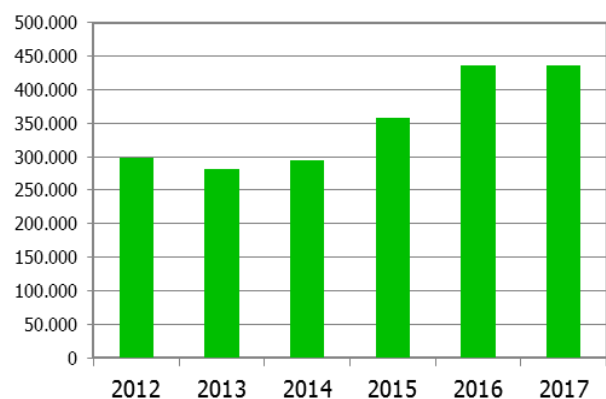

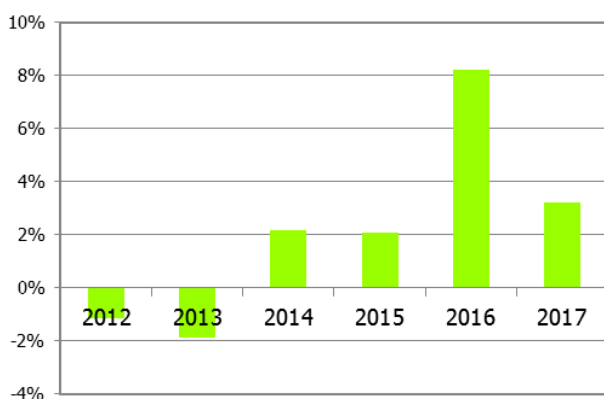
Revenues (in € 000)



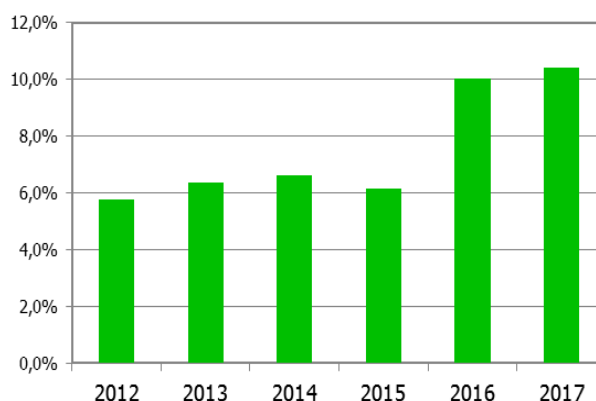
Gross profit (in € 000)
